Our deaf trainers will work with you and support you with your study. If you are over 15 years old and are deaf or hard of hearing, you are welcome to join our courses. Courses are held in Parramatta and will run for 19 weeks during Term 1. There will be a 2 week break in April.

On 1st October 2020, The Deaf Society merged with Deaf Services. Pending a transfer of our funding contracts, enrolments and qualifications will be accepted and issued for 2021 courses under the Deaf Services Registered Training Organisation called Access & Training Education (RTO number 41192). The training will be subsidised by the NSW Government.

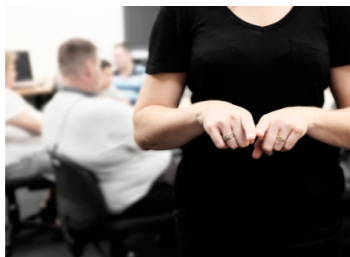
